4. What types of government policies and program create barriers to participation?

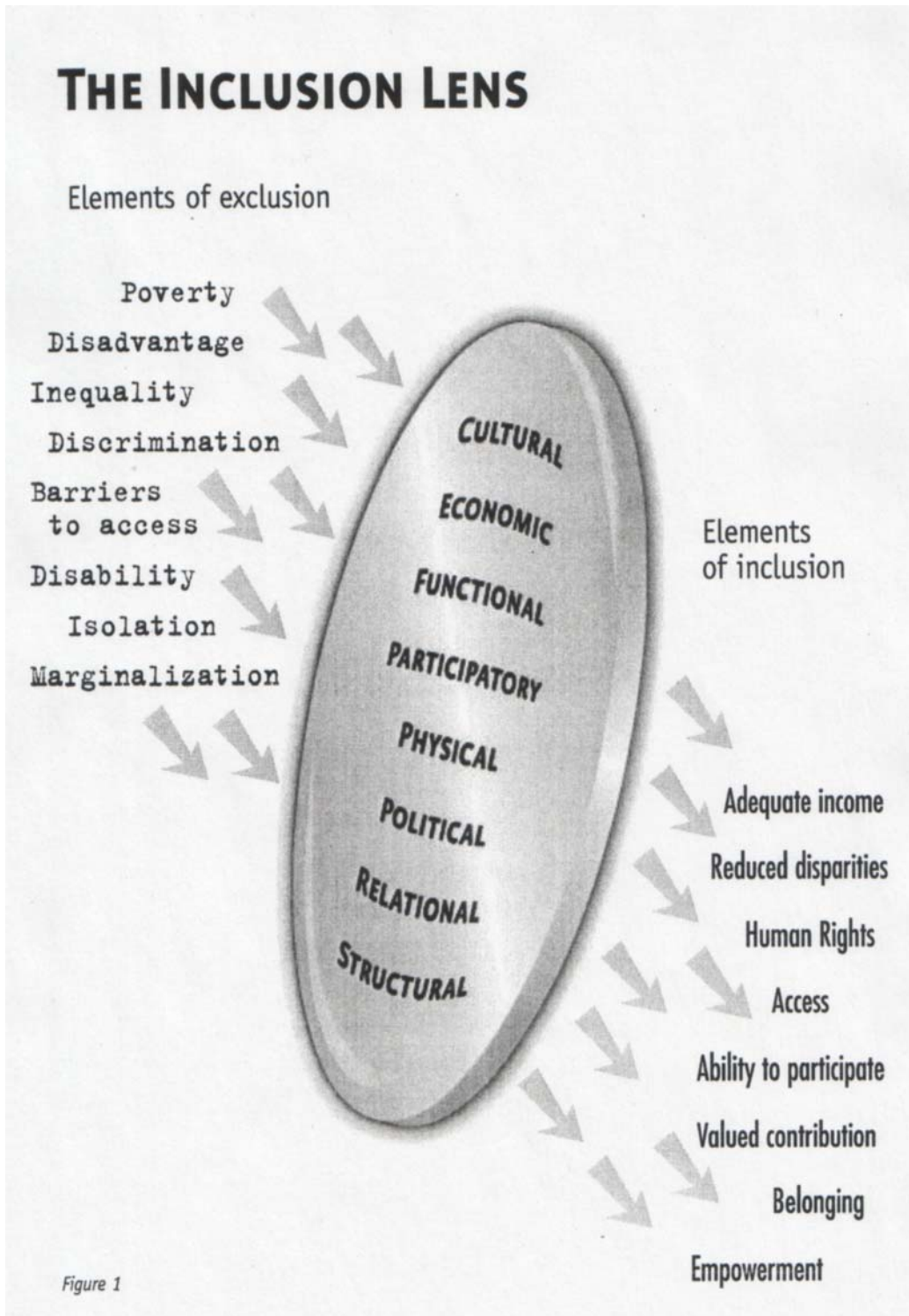

Values: the Foundation

In your next activity you will use the Inclusion Lens, this Lens requires a foundation of values to guide how it is used. These values are examples of the foundation used by many organizations to examine social and economic exclusion and inclusion.

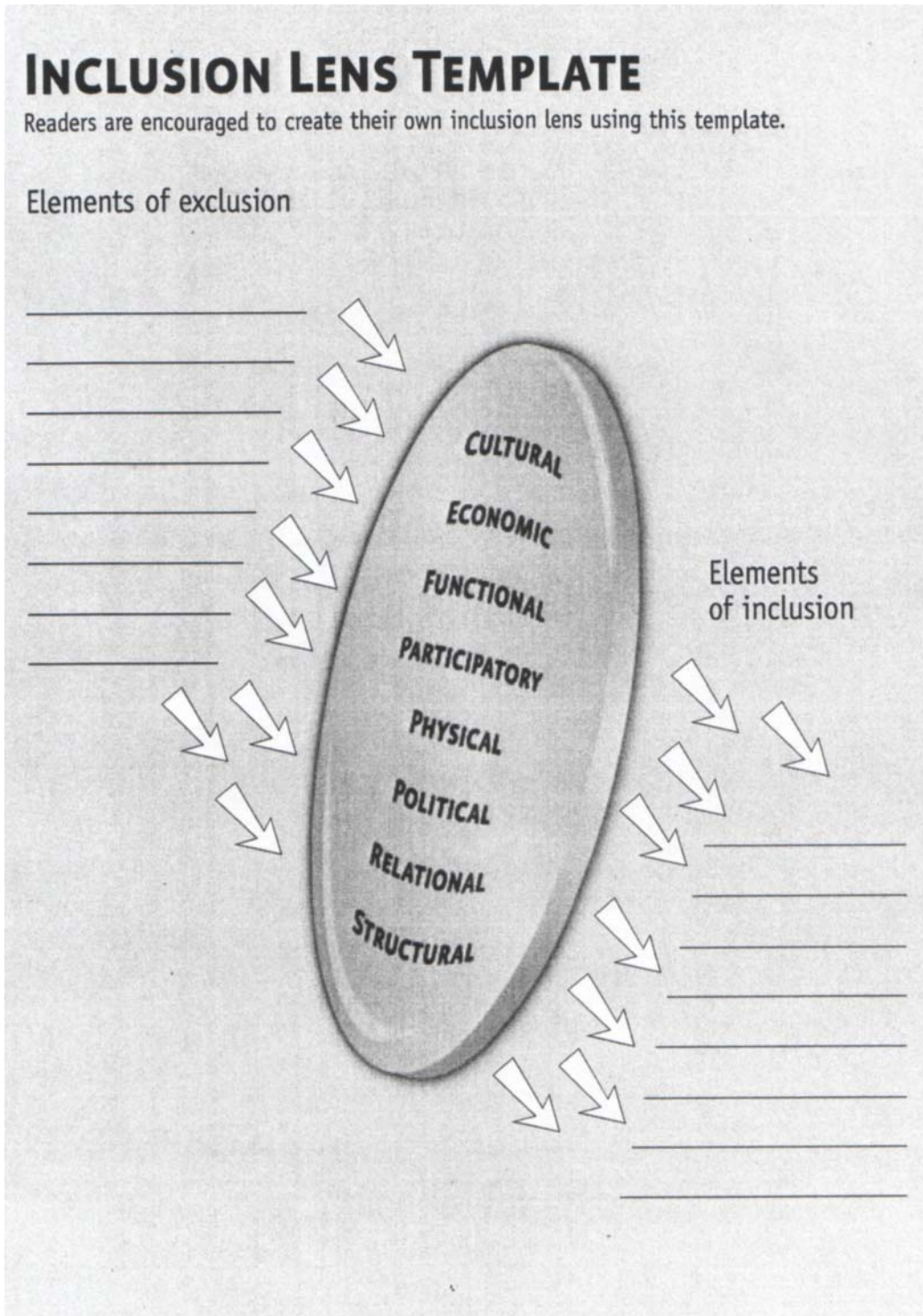
1. Social Justice - Distribution of the social and economic resources of society for the benefit of all people.
2. Valuing Diversity - Recognition and respect for the diversity of cultures, races, ethnicity, language, religions, abilities, age, and sexual orientation; valuing all contributions of both women and men to the social, economic, and cultural vitality of society.
3. Opportunities for Choices – Respect for the individuals to make choices that affect their lives.
4. Entitlement to Rights and Services – Recognition of universal entitlements to rights and services as set out in human rights covenants, charters, and legislation.
5. Working Together – Building common interests and relationships as the basis for actions to achieve shared goals.
